**STATEMENT OF FAMILY COMMITMENT**

As a family, we have read and understand the Central College Christian Academy's statement of faith, mission and purpose of Christian education, value of Christian education, non-discriminatory policy, philosophy of education, educational goals and objectives, code of conduct, and uniform policies.

We understand that in choosing a Christian setting for the education of our child, the Central College Christian Academy believes that it is important to be responsible, to establish and maintain a home and life environment which will support the Biblical teachings and beliefs of the Central College Christian Academy. We agree that our role as parent/legal guardian is crucial to the academic growth and success of our child and we will seek to be an example of the beliefs taught by the Central College Christian Academy. We, as parents, accept the challenge to train up a child in the way he or she should go (Proverbs 22:6), and we do state that this training will be carried on in the home. We place our trust in the Central College Christian Academy to extend this training more completely.

We understand that in an era where images of family relationships and personal sexuality are often confused and distorted, the Central College Christian Academy believes that it is important to teach and model the Biblical view. We understand that the Central College Christian Academy teaches with an age-appropriate curriculum, that sexual intimacy is intended by God to only be within the bonds of marriage between one man and one woman.

We understand that the Central College Christian Academy believes and teaches that children can best develop, spiritually and academically, where they can experience the influence of both their father and mother. The Central College Christian Academy believes that this is true, even when the circumstances of life have resulted in both parents no longer being present in the child's home. We understand that the Central College Christian Academy will emphasize the importance of the roles of both the father and the mother in its teachings and in seeking to partner with parents in the educational process.

We pledge that, if, for any reason, our child does not respond favorably to Central College Christian Academy, we will do everything in our power to cooperate with Central College Christian Academy to help make the necessary adjustment. If these adjustments cannot be made, then we agree to quietly withdraw our child.

We agree to pay all fees and understand that **the testing and academic fees are non-refundable.** We agree to pay tuition in one lump sum, in 10 monthly installments beginning with August and ending in May, or by special arrangements made with the CCCA office personnel. We understand that a late charge of \$25.00 will be added to the monthly amount if payment is not received by the fifth of each month. We understand and accept that failure to pay, or an arrears of three months, can result in dismissal from the Academy.
